The critters on this page are inspired by artwork from Mexico. The people of Oaxaca (pronounced Wa-HAH-ka), Mexico, craft intricate animals from copal wood. The wood is lightweight, easily workable, and sands to a smooth finish. The carvers do the initial chopping with machetes, then they finish the finer sculpting with pocketknives. It is often a family effort – children help with sanding, while wives may paint the vivid multicolored and detailed patterns. The carvers' inspirations come from their dreams, their farmyard animals, from their vibrant fiestas, even the wildflowers that grow in the desert. Each artist's outlook and personality is reflected in the graceful contours and brilliant colors of their creations.
